Kangia Camp is situated at the top of a plateau in a very nice spot with a view to Kangia fjord and Kangia River.

The Camp consists of 1 cabin with kitchen and living room, 1 accommodation cabin with 8 rooms and 2 beds in each room. 2 toilets and a shower. There can be a maximum of 12 guests at the camp at the same time during the whole fly-fishing season, which goes from the middle of July to the middle of October.

Kangia Camp is an exclusive fly-fishing camp, the only one in Greenland with international standard and quality. We offer you a unique experience.

### **Kangia River**

Kangia river is situated at the end of Kangia fjord, south of Maniitsoq (about. 1½ times sail trip). The area is hidden in a valley surrounded of mountains and wild fauna.

Kangia Camp roomed a maximum of 12 personer at the same time. After all the studies made by the local ATI school in Maniitsoq, this standart will keep the balance of the river.

## Program for Kangia Camp fly fishing package (monday - monday)

- Departure to airport at 07:15
- Departure to Kangerlussuaq at 07:50
